Guest Speaker: Glenise Pennell – Re food Distribution for local Schools' Brekky Clubs

Glenise had attended our Changeover diner and was amazed at what she learnt there of our work in the community.

She has been a local for many years and has had experience in employing volunteers, particularly when she formed and then directed the three local Alpha and Omega shops. Her current role, with her Salvation Army husband, is to source food for the school breakfast programs in 5 local schools including Noosaville and Tewantin schools where our club provides breakfast club support. These breakfast programs have been initiated by school chaplains.

Much food comes weekly from Brisbane under the umbrella of the Church of God while some comes from the COG food outlet here, purchases and lately our food donations. The recent ability to use our cool van has made distribution among the 5 school so much easier. Any excess food is given to the Anglican Church who provide a weekly BBQ at John's Landing.

The breakfast program provides more than food for students it gives them support and at times provides links to other support where needed. Glenise would like to see this program established in all schools and the chaplaincy program extended.

Linda, the chaplain at Tewantin and Sunshine Beach Schools, thanked all who had supported this program, noting how our donated food made the provision of emergency hampers so much easier,

Glenise was thanked by Shelia who spoke of the positive development in the children she sees regularly as a volunteer in the breakky program.




